Jeanna Phare Shukayr was born and raised in Plymouth, England. She danced all kinds of dancing, including square dancing, from an early age. She and Nasser first met in March 2004 at a square dance in Exeter, England. They were married in June 2006. Jeanna loves to be with square

From 2004 through 2009, Nasser and Jeanna were full-time callers for a Winter Texan program in the Harlingen area. In 2008 they moved to San Antonio.
