TREASURER'S REPORT: Beginning balance April 23, \$4,370.58. Ending balance August 12, \$4,651.03. Report was filed for audit.

District Presidents Report(s): July 23, 2023. The Northeast District talked about the Route 36 Dance hosted by the Peppy Promenaders and Tanglefoot Squares. Dave and Penny Byers, chairmen of both the Square Dance of the Year Committee and the Caller-Cuer Hall of Fame committee reminded the district presidents nominations for both of these awards are due by August 1. They also have a trailer available to use in parades; contact Dave and Penny. All of the districts indicated lessons are being started. Northwest District mentioned their district dance is August 12. She also reported the group discussed ways the Promotions Committee could get funds 222 to the clubs to help promote square dancing.

State Meeting Report(s): July 23, 2023. April meeting minutes were approved. A proposal to rename the Missouri State Festival to Missouri State Convention will be brought before the Board. Since it requires a Constitution change, it will be voted on in October. There were 218 Doin's mailed. There are 1,116 dancers insurance in Missouri. Carol Hershey made a report on the status of the State Festival. Liz Rooks reminded the Board about the Day of Dance during the State Fair in August. The Nominating Committee recommended that the current officers be re-elected for the coming year; election to be held at the October 15 meeting. Ordering signs for promoting square dancing was discussed. People were asked to go back to their local areas and see what signs cost at home. It might be cheaper to order locally.

The next planning meeting will be held August 23rd. Steve Bean showed a slide show of what he is preparing for the State Festival. It will displayed on a wall in the main dance hall. Everyone thought this was a good thing.
