Mary Alice Wheeler Pearson Miller of Oak Grove, Missouri, passed away February 5, 2022 at the St. Mary's Medical Center in Blue Springs, Missouri, following a short illness. She was 80 years and 11 days old. Mary was born in St. Clair County, Missouri, January 25, 1942, the daughter of Eugene Ray Wheeler & Myrtle Menelva Greathouse. Mary grew up on a farm near Osceola and graduated from Osceola High School. She attended Central Missouri State University in Warrensburg, Missouri.
