Lois Bess made motion to approve change, motion seconded, passed.

**Site Screening:** Don & Berneita Buck - Northeast district to find a place for 1995 festival, will have a report next meeting. Jim & Eloise Riley, Chairman; Dallas & Nancy Wheeler, Co-Chairman of the festival.

**Caller/Cuer:** Dean Osbourne - Reported 2 callers, Rusty Fennell, from Texas, has been charging \$600.00 plus airfare; Mark Turner, \$600.00 plus room. Looking for cuers.

**Insurance:** Larry & Dixie Foraker - Plan A income - \$2,318.80, 50 clubs. Plan B income - \$9,179.00 - 4310 members, plus 4 min. clubs 83 clubs. Everything is running a little ahead of 1993, on plan A and plan B.

**Blue Bird:** Debbie Bailey - Dorthy Ball reported: Beginning balance \$262.00—\$120.51 for 360 yards of braid, deposit \$13.50. Checkbook balance \$154.99. Total cash on hand \$164.00. She is running short of Blue birds—has 69 sets. Could run from 1-3 years. In July 1987, ordered 300 birds; cost \$1065.00. Done by Creative Screen Printing in Jefferson City. Has a bid from Kansas City Screen Printers for 5000 Blue Birds at 32 1/2C each. A bid from Green Hill Graphics, Brookfield, for 1100 birds, 550 each (\$605.00). Price does not include fabric they are printed on. \$1200.00 is set aside in treasury for Blue Birds. A committee was appointed to check into the blue birds, with Bettyrae Fluke & Berneita buck to work with Debbie, bring it back to next meeting. Motion made, seconded, passed.
