#### TRAVEL MISSOURI PROGRAM

TRAVEL MISSOURI is a statewide visitation program of the Missouri Federation of Square 'n Round Dance Clubs, Inc. designed to encourage dancers to visit other clubs, districts and attend the State Festival.

Participants may let people know what they have done by displaying the TRAVEL MISSOURI Bar with the District dangles identifying where they have danced. ALL SQUARE AND ROUND DANCES ARE TRAVEL MISSOURI DANCES.

Participation in TRAVEL MISSOURI cost nothing; however, the participant(s) may at their discretion obtain the Travel Missouri Bar and earn dangles from the Program Manager. To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.

- Americans spend 2 billion dollars on Easter goodies. They consume 7.1 billion pounds of Easter treats each year.
- According to a survey, 76% of people prefer to eat the ears of a chocolate Easter bunny first before any other part.
- No Easter celebration is complete without an Easter egg hunt. The party host tends to hide Easter eggs in the yard and the kids are supposed to fetch them. The one who finds the most eggs is the winner.
- $\bullet\,$  The idea of an egg laying rabbit originated in the 1700's through immigrants from Germany.
- The Egg painting custom is traditionally known as "Pysanka". The reason for painting Easter eggs in bright color's is that they represent the bright sunlight of springtime.
- Easter's most valuable eggs were hand crafted in the 1880's. Made by the great goldsmith Peter Carl Faberge, they were commissioned by Czar Alexander III of Russia as gifts for his wife, Czarina Maria Feodorovna. The first Faberge egg, presented in 1886, measured two and a half inches long and had a simple exterior.
- The most famously known Easter event took place in the year 1878. This year president Hayes and his wife Lucy officially opened the White House grounds to the children for egg rolling on Easter Monday. Since then, this event is held each year.

#### LET'S TOOT OUR HORN

#### A PROJECT OF THE PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE

This award is to promote publication of square and round dance club activities in local and state media; to increase participation in district and state functions; to improve public relations with non-members and to encourage clubs to set and attain goals they can be proud of.

The first year a "Horn" will be presented to each qualifying club that can be pinned to their club banner. A bar will be added for each completed year after the first. Horn or bar awards will be will be mailed or presented to each club completing the requirements.

During the program year, January 1 through December 31, a club must complete at least six items out of the twelve proposed items. The first two are required and must be two of the six.

#### REQUIRED:

- Place at least three items in a local media during the year that reaches all the public and mentions square dancing. This can include local or regional newspapers, radio stations, television station, billboards, or any announcement that reaches the public. This does not include articles in local church papers or postings in grocery stores.
- 2. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at your home District Dance.

#### Plus complete a minimum of 4 items from the following:

- 1. Place at least four (4) articles or ads in the Doin's.
- Perform three philanthropic activities during the year (i.e. holding a benefit dance, conducting a fund raiser for needy persons or organization, providing a scholarship of some kind to someone, assisting in a food pantry collection, be part of an adopt-a-family for a holiday, or bell ringing for the Salvation Army, etc.)
- Visit a public or private organization in the local community and conduct a square dance for their entertainment and to promote square dancing.
- 4. Participate as a club in a community event such as a fall festival, national holiday celebration, or any other type of city, county or local event. This can include helping in the necessary set-up, working in a booth, taking part in a parade, or making a club contribution to the event.
- 5. Have at least one square (8 dancers) at Missouri State Festival
- 6. Place an ad of any size in the State Festival Book
- 7. Host a Missouri Federation State Board meeting
- 8. Have a current District officer or State officer or delegate from club membership
- 9. Conduct a complete set of lessons
- 10. Visit at another districts' District Dance with at least one square (8 dancers)

Reporting is to be done to the Promotions Chairman on this form as soon as the project is completed (no later than February 1 of the year following) within the guidelines of January 1 through December 31 of the current year.

A list of all clubs that complete the current year will be printed in the Doin's.

#### Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance.

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other winter weather events such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornados or other concerns and issues may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance at the last minute.

During these weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen as scheduled, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

You can also tune in to your local weather forecasts on your radio, television, computer and smart phone apps before traveling, regardless of the reason of travel.

A very good investment is a NOAA Weather Radio. These can be purchased at almost any electronics store or department store. Be sure to buy one with the **SAME** Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service provides alerts concerning severe weather 24 hours a day.

You can also go to weather.gov on the internet and click on whichever state you are in for the latest watches, warnings, advisories and forecasts.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter conditions or flooding, tornados, severe wind conditions, or road construction, go to the State Traffic and Road Closures on the internet to find out the condition of your planned route to a dance or other event.

**REMEMBER:** Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the roadways.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

The following in order of importance was: Dance calendar, Club Directory, Club articles, Location listing, State festival information.

Carol stated that they will be looking into reducing the size of the ads of the Missouri programs such as Toot your Horn and possibly making them every other issue.

**DOIN's Editor:** Edythe Weber reporting: The next deadline for the DOIN's will be January 25, 2017. Please send in your information early because Jim and Edythe will be attending the USDA meeting in warm San Antonio, Texas. Fifteen clubs have not sent in their 2017 schedule. These are needed right away. The Jan/

Feb issue will also include the pull-out location pages. Please use them.

One issue of the DOIN's is provided for each new dancer. Make your request for copies on a form available on the Missouri Federation website at www. squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri. Click on Federation Information, then Show-Me DOIN's. If you want the forms sent to you electronically to save to your computer, please send an email to doins@kc.rr.com and we will send them to you.

There was a real problem with the November/December issue delivered in a select portion of the state. This was due to a bill passed by U.S. Congress regarding priority of post office delivery which is first class mail, political mail and then all the rest. The DOIN's is taken to the bulk mail center 10 working days prior to the end of the month, normally more than enough time to get it to you by the 1st of the issue month. This will continue.

**DOIN's Circulation:** Jim Weber reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN's this month were 339. The advertisers get a copy with two exchange copies and 13 for staff, historian and post office. The January/ February mailing will be 353. We received 96 renewals, 20 new copies went to students and we have 30 people that will not receive the March-April issue unless they renew. We will be sending out 30 postcards to subscribers.

<u>Financial report.</u> The balance brought forward was \$100 with total income of \$2,238 from subscriptions. Expenses of postage and other amounted to \$21.64. A check for \$2,216.36 was given to the Federation which also includes the \$528 donation from the DOIN's dance. The ending balance was \$100.

**DOIN's Advertising:** Dave Shafer reporting. We had a balance brought forward of \$100 and took in revenue of \$15 cash on subscription renewals, DOIN's ads revenue and caller/cuer listings of \$564 with a donation given to us of \$35 gave us a total ad revenue of \$714. Expenses totaled \$64.74. A check was given today to the Federation for \$549.26 leaving us a balance of \$100. There is no puzzle report because we have no more puzzles.

George Roth noted we are still looking for an Advertising Chairman. Contact Dave or Jim Weber for further information.

**Promotions and Advertising:** Jack Rockaway reporting. Two clubs have responded to Toot Your Horn. We will be giving out the awards in February so get your clubs to submit their applications. The form is on the website and the deadline is February 1, 2017.

**State Festival Site Screening:** Dan Reedy – No report.

**Insurance Coordinator:** Jim Weber reporting. In 2016 the dancers insured through Missouri was 1,449. Dancers insured thru other federations were 390 for a total of Missouri dancers, 1,839 with 58 clubs. So far for 2017, 1,264 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation, and through other federations, 328 for a total at this time of 1,592. We lost two clubs this year, the Ozark Zigzags and the Jacks and Queens.

Remember to submit the club sponsored class form. As of January, 2017, new dancers in lessons will be covered anywhere they dance, if the club sponsoring the lessons has completed and filed the Missouri club sponsored class form for 2017. Fifty-five clubs will receive the \$35 club reimbursement for having their 2017 club

state dues paid and the club's 2017 insurance forms filed by November 1, 2016.

If a dancer goes to a club that is not insured, that dancer is still covered for accidental/medical even though the club is not. In that case, the dancer would be responsible for filling out their own paperwork. If the club has liability insurance they will fill out the forms for you.

**Travel Missouri:** Jim Marron reporting: As of November 3, 2016, the total number of dangles given out for Missouri was 425.

Central – 380; Southeast – 329; St. Louis – 340; Northwest – 334; West Central – 360; Southwest – 383; Northeast -- 367

The grand total for all districts is 2,918. We have 276 members. Total income for October was \$19 with (two new members and 1 badge holder). Disbursements for October totaled \$21.78 (10 new magnets badge holders). If anyone is interested, they are \$2.00 each. Total income for the year was \$167.18 and Total expenses for 2016 were \$69.96. Total money in the account is \$97.22.

**Blue Bird Coordinator:** Connie and Kenny Hobbs. Absent – No report.

**Webmaster:** Dan Wheeler reporting. When putting down the Missouri State website, please make it www.squaredancemissouri.com. Do not enter or copy any forward slash information after the .com. It is not necessary and oftentimes that's where a mistake in typing occurs. When you put web addresses in print, it is good to put the "www" in front of it because the computer will more easily recognize this because it is a web address. When you are putting a web address on a flyer, after you have typed it, paste it into the address line in your browser to see if it will open.

St. Louis is on the internet for 2017. Please tell your clubs to send me their schedules and I will put them up. Also, I have discovered something called, "return to previous page" and a lot of the web pages on the Missouri website now have that at the top and almost always you can click on that and go back to where you were.

Snow is coming. If you go to the Notices and Cancellations page it tells people how to let me know the dance will be cancelled. The fastest way to let me know is by texting me or by calling my cell phone. I need the information for the Caller Hall of Fame for this year and the Square Dancer of the Year. Whoever has those books, I need the latest pages so I can add them to the website.

**Historian:** Dan Weber reporting. All the minutes that Dan has are on the website. Click on Archives and minutes of past meetings to view the minutes. Anything that comes up in black instead of blue Is something he doesn't have. If you have it, please give the information to Dan.

**License Plate:** Sharon White – No report.

**USDA:** Edythe Weber reporting: Jim and I will be attending the winter meeting to be held in San Antonio, Texas this coming January.

**ARTS:** Edythe Weber - There was no report but keep up to date by getting on the email list. Go to the website http://LiveLivelySquareDance.com and sign up.

District Presidents' Report: Liz Rooks reported that Jim Weber talked with the District Presidents on insurance forms and filling information out for our district dances and events.

Exemption for New Callers/Cuers at State Festivals: Dan Reedy reporting. The proposed revision of Section 5, Paragraph C regarding Exemption for New Callers/ Cuers at State Festival that was tabled at the October meeting was removed from the table and opened for discussion. Dan's recommendation was to either rewrite the paragraph and extend the time to 24 months or make no change. After discussion, Jim Weber called the motion, seconded by Fred Goucher to be voted on. A "No" vote would be to leave the wording as is; and a "Yes" vote would to move forward and change the wording from 12 to 24 months. A hand vote was taken and the motion carried to stay as it is currently written.

Dan also checked on the use of membership cards and he found only two clubs are actively using them. Unless the Federation wants to use the cards, his recommendation would be to give them to the clubs that are using them.

Showcase of Ideas: President Roth requested that someone step forward and volunteer for that position. Anyone that is interested please see Dave Shafer for more information.

National Convention: Carl and Cindy Boone reporting. Carl asked Wanda Kruse

to give an update on the raffle quilt. She stated that we now have raffle tickets for the quilt and they are 6 for \$5. The quilt has been appraised for \$7,500 due in part to all the documentation in making the quilt, patterns used, and workmanship of the dancers who worked on it.

Carl stated plans are in place for the Pre-Convention dance in March, 2017. They have traveled to as many state festivals as possible selling registrations, and Way and Means are selling well.

Rosa Davis has a pattern for a star square dance pot holder that she has offered to make if anyone would like to donate fabric to her.

Edythe Weber stated that their club has a 50-50 pot and they will be saving that up to make a donation to the National. They have also received funds back from the Fit N' Fun and that money will also be donated to the National. She noted there are things that each club can do to make a donation. The most important thing is to get your dancers registered now.

**Audit Committee for 2016:** President Roth announced the Audit Committee for 2016. Liz Rooks as Chairman, Tom Miller, and Kurt Brockhaus have been chosen for this task. Please bring your books to the next meeting so the Audit Committee can begin the audit.

President Roth released the committees for 2016. He thanked them for their service and also acknowledged that he and Cleva had enjoyed working with everyone as President. He passed the gavel on to Dan Reedy, as the new President for 2017.

Dan thanked the Central District and hosts, Andy and Fayette Stewart for the nice lunch and meeting place, and stated he is looking forward to working with everyone in the coming year.
