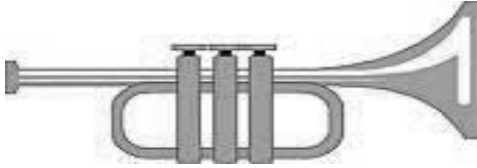

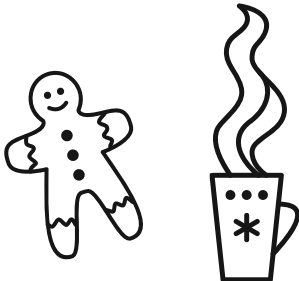
Important deadline NOVEMBER 25:

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

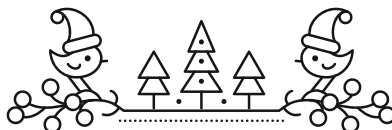
1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

We want to thank all those who "Got Your Kicks on Rt. 36" and made it a success. It was a fun time for all who were involved.

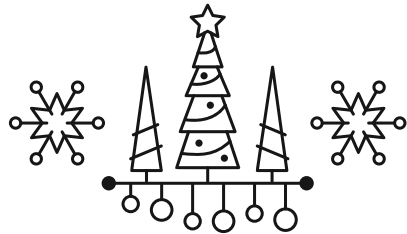

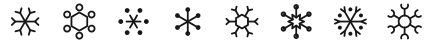

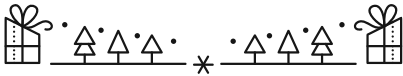

Remembering Jim Weber...

James Milton Weber, former Division Chief of the Liberty, Missouri Fire Department, passed away September 11, 2020.

Jim was born July 1, 1946, in Laredo, MO, the elder of two children of Herman "Micky" and Marjorie "Rose" (Peterie) Weber. He graduated from Laredo High School in 1964 and soon joined the US Navy. Jim served from 1964 until receiving honorable discharge from active duty in 1968 and reserve duty in 1970. Jim later pursued his Associate's degree at Penn Valley Community College.



Jim was united in marriage to Mary Susan Stevens. She preceded him in death on June 13, 1984. He was later united in marriage in 1986 to Edythe (Lane) McGuire who survives.

Jim's father was a volunteer firefighter and mother a volunteer EMT. He carried on their traditions and became a career firefighter, EMT and Paramedic. He worked a short time for the Trenton, MO Fire Department before moving to Liberty in 1972. His career with the Liberty Fire Department spanned more than three decades, retiring as a Division Chief. Jim was one of Missouri's earliest paramedics.

Jim was very active in his community. He served as a leader in Boy Scout Troop 374 in Liberty with his son Brad. He was an Eagle Scout and a Firebuilder in the Tribe of Mic-O-Say. Jim was active in Clay County 4-H in shooting sports and fishing projects with his stepsons.

Jim was a Past Commander of VFW Post 4043 in Liberty, serving on its funeral honors team. He sent weekly reminders for breakfast at Ma and Pa's in Claycomo. Jim was a member of American Legion Post 95 in Liberty.

Jim and Edythe were very active in square dancing in Liberty and throughout Missouri. He was Past President of the Heart of America Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs, Past President and current Insurance Chairman for the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs. Jim and Edythe were selected Square Dancer of the Year in 2007. Jim was Past President and served every elected office on the Executive Committee of the United Square Dancers of America. He was Editor of the Show Me Doin's Square Dance Magazine, served as Webmaster for USDA and for the Alliance of Round, Traditional and Square Dance, Inc. He was President of the Ramblers Square Dance Club in Liberty.

Along with his parents and first wife, Jim was preceded in death by stepson, Grover McGuire, Jr.

Survivors include his wife, Edythe; children, Shelly Graham (Bob) of Kansas City, Bradley Weber (Allyson) of Lexington, Tracy Geier (Dicky) and Tim McGuire both of Liberty; 13 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren; sister, Freida Troester (Richard) of Trenton, two nieces and their families, as well as other family members and countless friends.

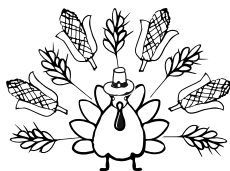

Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance.

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other winter weather events such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornadoes or other concerns and issues may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance at the last minute.

During these weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen as scheduled, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

You can also tune in to your local weather forecasts on your radio, television, computer and smart phone apps before traveling, regardless of the reason of travel.

A very good investment is a NOAA Weather Radio. These can be purchased at almost any electronics store or department store. Be sure to buy one with the SAME Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service provides alerts concerning severe weather 24 hours a day.

You can also go to weather.gov on the internet and click on whichever state you are in for the latest watches, warnings, advisories and forecasts.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter conditions or flooding, tornadoes, severe wind conditions, or road construction, go to the State Traffic and Road Closures on the internet to find out the condition of your planned route to a dance or other event.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the roadways.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

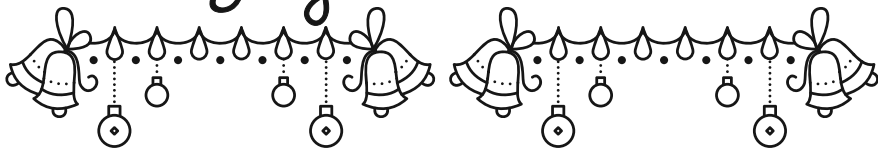

Jingle What?!



"Jingle Bells" was originally a Thanksgiving song...

Turns out, we were originally dashing through the snow for an entirely different holiday. James Lord Pierpont wrote a song called "One Horse Open Sleigh" for his church's Thanksgiving concert. Then in 1857, the song was re-published under the title it still holds today, and it eventually became one of the most popular Christmas songs.

Astronauts broadcast "Jingle Bells" from space...

This prank almost went too far. Nine days before Christmas in 1965, the two astronauts aboard Gemini 6 sent an odd report to Mission Control that they saw an "unidentified flying object" about to enter Earth's atmosphere, traveling in the polar orbit from north to south. They interrupted the tense report with the sound of "Jingle Bells," as Wally Schirra played a small harmonica accompanied by Tom Stafford on a handful of small sleigh bells they had smuggled aboard.

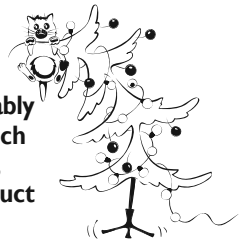
Not to worry about December... we had already decided NOT to have a dance in December. Hopefully we'll be back in January.

Roll Call: Liz Rooks. Full Quorum achieved. (7 Executive Board; 13 District Directors; 10 Staff/Past Presidents.)

Approval of April 19 Minutes: President Goucher asked for corrections or additions to the minutes that had been e-mailed to everyone prior to the meeting.

Edythe Weber moved to accept the minutes as emailed. Motion was seconded by Dave Shafer and motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Rosa Davis reported a beginning checking balance as of May 31, 2020 of \$9,722.44, Revenue of \$430.26 and Expenses of \$4,760.02. The ending checking account balance as of July 31, 2020 is \$5,392.58. Total CDs and interest amounted to \$40,724.16 for Total Funds on hand of \$46,116.74.

The check originally written for the State Fair ad in the Fair Souvenir book was voided as the Sedalia Democrat reduced the price from \$550 to \$500 and a new check was written; that check has also been voided since there will not be a souvenir booklet this year.

The Treasurer's report will be submitted for audit.

Membership and Club Longevity: Rosa Davis reported we have 46 clubs this year. Longevity awards were announced for Little Dixie Squares in the Northeast District for 50 years and Dandy Dancers in St. Louis Metro for 55 years.

Correspondence: Liz Rooks reporting. No correspondence has been received. A Get Well or Thinking of You card will be sent to Mike Sikorsky and a Sympathy card to Chris Wildhagen.

Boundaries and Relations: Dave Byers. No additional report; waiting for an in-person meeting for further discussion. Jim Weber suggested this be tabled for the time being.

Constitution and Bylaws: : Dave Shafer. Nothing new to report. Approval of the previously proposed Constitution change will be taken up at Unfinished Business.

Publications: Carol Morris. No report at this time; waiting to see whether they will be able to host the Doin's Dance in October.

DOIN'S Editor: Edythe Weber reporting. Edythe asked everyone present to encourage the clubs in their area to submit an article, even a short one, for each issue to help the Federation be able to meet the criteria of the Post Office for the mailing rate we have.

The next deadline is September 25 for the November-December issue. Please send early.

DOIN'S Circulation: Ruth Ann Reynolds reporting. Subscriptions for the DOIN'S this month were 262, 1 exchange copy and 14 for staff, historian and post office for a total mailing of 277. We had 55 electronic subscriptions, 65 renewals 4 new subscriptions and zero copies went to new students. We will be sending out 11 postcards to subscribers whose subscriptions will expire with the September-October issue.

Financial report: The balance brought forward was \$100 with a total income of \$180.00 from subscriptions. Total expenses of \$133.84. A check for \$46.16 was given to the Federation. The ending balance is \$100.

DOIN's Advertising: Dave Shafer reporting. We had a balance brought forward of \$100. We took in revenue from DOIN'S ads and caller/cuer listings of \$286.00; Expenses totaled \$7.75. A check was given to the Federation for \$278.25, leaving us a balance of \$100.

Promotions and Advertising: Jack & Becky Rockaway. No report.

State Festival Site Screening: Dave & Penny Byers. No report.

Insurance Coordinator: Jim Weber reporting. 1,100 dancers are insured through Missouri Federation and 357 dancers are insured through other federations for a total of 1,457 Missouri dancers in 46 clubs.

Jim also shared information regarding questions he had received as to what our insurance does and does not cover pertaining to the Covid-19 pandemic situation as well as information regarding how and when to use the insurance portal. A copy of his full report is on file.

Financial Report: Beginning balance as of June 2, 2020, was \$263.15; total income of \$24.25 and expenses of \$23.75 leaves an ending balance on August 10, 2020, of \$ 263.65

Travel Missouri: Jim Marron reporting. No report.

Blue Bird Coordinator: Madeline Hall. No report.

Webmaster: Dan Wheeler reporting. Not much is happening on the Missouri Federation website.

The biggest thing is cancellations. It is important that your clubs keep their dance schedule current. We hope that someday soon we will be dancing again. I have taken this time to reformat a number of web pages, so if you open a web page, and it looks a little different, that's why.

Historian: Dan Wheeler reporting. No report.

License Plate: Catherine McLemore reporting. Catherine was not present but had submitted her report to the Secretary. Nine 2 year and two 1 year renewals have been received for a total of \$500 deposited and \$200 refunded. Beginning balance of account was \$83.36 and an ending balance as of this report of \$383.36.

There has been only one new plate request received this year. I feel we really need to promote this program more and plan to campaign harder when we actually get back to having dances. Please talk to your friends and club members about the square dance license plates and convince them it is a very positive marketing tool and it shows our pride in our activity.

USDA: Edythe Weber and Dave Shafer reporting. Edythe reported that the Annual meeting of the United Square Dancers of America was held on Saturday, June 20 by Zoom meeting on computer/phone. Also attending the meeting were Dave Shafer, Rosalie Mogerman, and Penny and Dave Byers delegates.

Dave Shafer reporting: The virtual meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. In 2020, a \$500.00 scholarship was presented to Petrina Bucheit, and a \$1,000 scholarship was awarded to Julia Bucheit, both of Silverton, Oregon.

The president reported: They had authorized the renewal of the USDA Insurance program.

Beginning in August and continuing into December, they are working with the Youth Revision Committee to revise the Scholarship scoring rubric and the four USDA Youth Trifolds.

USDA is now a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Central Group Administrator as of December 2019.

Prescription Card status was reported by Joy Vaccari. She reminded everyone that the USDA Prescription Card works even if you have insurance. It always pays to carry the card and ask when you get a prescription filled or refilled. You may be able to save. The enhanced card may also help with vision and hearing services.

Insurance report given by Elizabeth Sanders. For the first time, the enrollment process was done by computer. It was a learning experience, but overall went well.

The number of dancers insured through USDA continues to decrease. In 2014, there were 38,119 dancers insured. Today, there are 26,279 dancers insured.

ARTS: Edythe Weber reporting. Meeting was held via Zoom on June 21. ARTS is working on with Square developing a way for pay membership, donations and other ways to support the ARTS to be paid on line with credit card.

Our Annual Associate dues of \$100 is due.

Anyone wanting to support ARTS and be an individual member should check the website. You can also become a member of the \$100 Club by donating \$100 to the ARTS.

Youth and Children's Dance: Merle Hall. No report.

Mo Fed Scholarship: Bob & Shirley Turner. Brianna Butler, granddaughter of Billie Jean Butler, is this year's recipient. Check will be sent to her college in September. The 2021 cycle will open in January with applications due March 1, 2021.

2020 State Festival: Liz Rooks. As of this date there are 24 callers and cuers registered. There are 57 registered dancers with 21 of those being complimentary registrants and 36 paying registrants. Will share more details in New Business when discussing whether or not to hold this year's festival.

Old Business:

District realignment: Discussion tabled until an in-person meeting is able to be held.

Dave Shafer, Bylaws Committee Chairman read the proposed wording for changes to Article V, Officers and Duties, Section 2, Duties, letter D of the Constitution, Missouri Federation of Square'N Round Dance Clubs, Inc.

Proposal was voted on and accepted.

Merle Hall reported he had completed the paperwork for our a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit application with the exception of the necessary financial information and was waiting to receive that from Rosa. Rosa indicated she had sent it earlier, however, would resend.

Jim Weber suggested at this point we wait until 2021 to submit the application as if we do it now we would just have to do it again in 2021.

Merle will present the full report for approval by the Board of Directors at a future meeting.

New Business:

Fred Goucher, president, opened the floor for discussion regarding the 2020 State Festival.

Liz Rooks presented information regarding funds currently on hand as well as the amount of basic expenses we would be committed to if we proceeded with the festival as well as some other projected expenses and the projected number of additional registrations needed.

Merle Hall made a motion to go forward with the awards and select the recipients for Square Dancer of the Year and Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame. Motion was seconded by Dave Shafer; motion carried.

Merle Hall made a motion to ask the recipients to be at our October state meeting to receive their award. Jim Weber seconded the motion; motion carried.

Cathy Hall, Audit Committee Chairman, gave the following report of the books for 2019 that were audited.

The audit was done on August 10, 2020 by Cathy Hall and Gary King from the St. Louis District; the third member of the committee was unable to attend due to health reasons. They reviewed the financial records of the State Treasurer (i.e. General Fund), Doin's circulation, Doin's Advertising, and Insurance Coordinator.

Overall, the financials as presented and reviewed were complete and recordkeeping methods are approved.

The committee's full report is on file with the Secretary.

Jim Weber reminded everyone there are a number of people who plan to renew their Doin's subscription at the Doin's Dance held on Sunday following the festival. These folks need to remember they will need to mail in their renewal this year.

Dave Shafer suggested consideration be given to combining the Youth & Children's Dance and Scholarship Committees into one committee since some of their work overlaps. Jim Weber shared that probably would not be a good idea as having separate committees improves the chances of being able to receive grant money to help with their work.

Whether to hold the October state meeting on the 11th or 18th was discussed. It is hoped this can be an in person meeting with the option available for those who choose not to do in person to join online as there are some topics that need to be discussed that would best be done in an in person setting.

Debbie Moffitt made a motion to hold the meeting on Oct. 18. Motion seconded by Jim Weber. Motion approved.

The meeting can be held in Sedalia, Missouri hosted by the Diamond B's of the West Central District at the ABC Building, 4th & Osage.

Madeline Hall moved the motion be adjourned. Motion seconded by Dave Shafer; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 1:55 p.m.

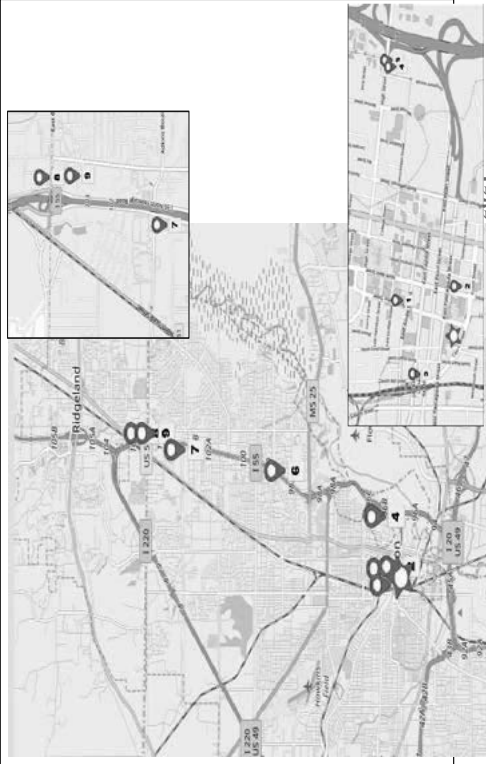
