Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other weather events, such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornados or other concerns may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance.

During weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter or flooding conditions, go to the State Traffic and Road Closure on the internet to find out the condition or your planned route.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the highway.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.

In Memory Dorotha Campbell




