GUIDELINES

Beginner Callers Support

TO RECEIVE 1/4-PAGE FREE ADVERTISING IN THE
SHOW-ME DOIN'S FOR ONE YEAR

*Submit the following to the State Board of the Missouri
Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs:*

1. New caller show proof of successfully completing an acknowledged calling school within the past 12 months.
2. Be a member of an acknowledged caller association — CALLERLAB or American Callers Association.
3. Reside within a district of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs and/or be affiliated with a club of the Missouri Federation.
4. Show proof of BMI/ASCAP licensing.
5. Provide business card or desired ad layout for the *Show-Me Doin's*.

Send all requested information to the President of the Missouri Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs for presentation of request at the next available State Board meeting.

Call Ahead FIRST Before Traveling to a Dance

Severe weather, e.g. snow, icy roads, and other weather events, such as Flooding, Thunder Storms, Tornadoes or other concerns may cause the club you plan to visit to cancel their dance.

During weather events, or if a weather event is forecast, call the club contact ahead of time to ensure that the dance you are planning to attend is either going to happen, or has been cancelled. You can find a list of club contacts at the back of the Show-Me Doin's.

If you know that road closures may be a problem due to winter or flooding conditions, go to the State Traffic and Road Closure on the internet to find out the condition or your planned route.

REMEMBER: Never attempt to drive through flooded low water crossings or other waters on the highway.

We want to see you across a square. So, travel safely and sanely.





Ronald (Mac) Clyde McReynolds (87) Joplin, MO passed away November 23, 2024, at 5:30 a.m. Ronald was born May 30, 1937, in Joplin, MO. to John Morris McReynolds and Etta Marie (Turner) McReynolds. EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID

1. When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends to him/her.
2. Remaining dancers join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
3. Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arch.
4. On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an emergency call for aid.

TRAVEL MISSOURI PROGRAM

To earn dangles you will need a TRAVEL MISSOURI card (which may be obtained from the Program Manager, District Presidents, or Club Presidents or by visiting www.squaredancemissouri.com). Each time a participant who has obtained the Travel Missouri Bar visits a different district, he or she may have a card signed by the host club. To receive the Dangles, send the signed card to the Program Manager and the dangles and a new card will be sent to you. One card is good per couple or individuals.
