I often see links to those pages with the long address from the top of the browser instead of those short EZ addresses. Those EZ address are there to make it easy for people to type in that web address. Most of the time when someone types in those long addresses they make a typo and the pages don't open.

The forms on the website are all in pdf format. They can be downloaded from the website. Most of them have been set up so that you can actually fill them out before you download them if you want to. When you do fill them out on your computer, the people receiving them will actually be able to read them. This is particularly true of E-Mail addresses. However, If you send me a request for a form, I am happy to send it to you, but you can usually get the form faster by downloading it from the website.
