Club colors were red and navy blue.

Puxico Country Squares had 35 charter members. Only three of the charter members are still dancing today. Dale & Margaret Ann Sifford were the first presidents. The first caller and teacher were Dale & Betty Phillips of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

The club became a member of the Missouri Federation of Square & Round Dance in June of 1982. The club still has an average of 35 members today and still dances twice a month at the Puxico VFW hall.
