State Meeting Report(s): Edythe Weber reported:

- 1. Meeting called to order, roll call, approval of minutes and treasurer's report.
- 2. Rosa Davis reported 49 clubs have paid their 2018 dues.
- 3. Dan Reedy reported: 1 Leadership Rebate; 1 Callers Rebate and 6 Youth Rebates have been mailed out.
- 4. Edythe Weber reported that the Doin's is available online now. It can be checked out at <u>http://www.squaredancemissouri.com/Missouri/Doins.php</u>
- 5. Jim Weber reported that the 2019 insurance packets will be mailed out in September.
- 6. Dan Wheeler would like to have you 2018-2019 dance schedules to put up on the website.
- 7. District Presidents' Report: Liz Rooks reported Square Dancer of the Year has been selected.

Lessons are beginning across the state.

- 8. Sharon & Larry Crisel reported 7 youth from Missouri were in the Hall at the Nationals, 6 qualified for the rebate. 77 registered all together and 65 badges were given out.
- 9. 2018 State Festival, Larry and Sharon Crisel reported most of the work is completed and ready for the dancers.
- 10. National Convention, Carl and Cindy Boone reported 3,170 in attendance. 585 were Missouri square dancers. A BIG THINKS TO ALL THAT HELPED.

- 11. 2019 State Festival, Catherine McLemore reporting the Southwest District is moving forward for the State Festival. They are ready to be off and running at the end of this year's festival.
- 12. Dan Reedy reported that the 2018 Caller/Cuer Hall of Fame has been selected.
- 13. Liz Rooks reported the State Fair had a good turnout. 200 people signed in. Had good publicity from the state fair. The booklet with the ad went to 100,000 people in the state and 13,000 Daily Fliers were printed.
- 14. Jack Rockaway announced he would like to order 50 more Square Dance signs. A motion was made, and 100 more signs will be purchased.

OLD BUSINESS:

Northwest District Dance July 28: Finalized report on dance.

Reported that not as much money was made this year as last.

Next year's dance will be August 10 at Graceway.

There was a conflict of dates with other dances in the area, the date for the Northwest District Dance will be August 10, 2019. Also, clubs should be thinking about hosting the dance in 2019.

Other Old Business:

Edythe Weber had a receipt for the basket from Nationals for \$49.17. Dan Wheeler moved that "the full receipt be paid to Edythe." Motion seconded and passed.

Discussion on Friendship Visitation: Edythe Weber asked if clubs were participating in the Friendship Visitation program and suggested that the requirements be put in the minutes.

NORTHWEST DISTRICTFRIENDSHIP VISITATIONS

The purpose of this award is to encourage Northwest District Visitations to other clubs in the Northwest District, as well as visitation to organized square dance clubs and square dance events in other areas. Events being: State, District, National Festivals as well as Exhibitions or Demonstrations meant to encourage new people to

become square dancers (Lessons are not included). Also, to encourage clubs of all sizes to participate by giving each club an equal opportunity to get credit for their members participation at a visitation by awarding on a percentage of membership attending.

The percentage will be figured by District Secretary from the membership applications turned in at the beginning of the year (Jan-Dec). Each club will have a copy of their percentages published in the Northwest District Handbook.

Each club will be given a card to be signed at the visitation, noting the number of dancers attending. At the end of the year (this to run from June 1 to June 1, with earned awards to be given at the Northwest District Dance), the card will be turned into the District Visitation Chairman by June 15, who will determine:

- 1. RED the club with the highest percentage of members attending visitations, as well as the highest number of clubs visited during the year.
- 2. WHITE the club with the second highest percentage of members attending visitations, as well as the second highest number of clubs visited during the year.
- 3. BLUE the club with the third highest percentage of members attending visitations, as well as the third highest number of clubs visited during the year.
- 4. No club will be allowed to count more than one visit per night!
- 5. Any one dancer can only represent one club per dance.
- 6. A Friendship Certificate will be given to all North West District Clubs participating in the visitation program upon receipt of the Friendship Visitation Card
