# Southwest District Meeting Minutes September 10, 2022

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Reported by Sharon Glenn. Copies of the financial report for the period of May 14, 2022 through September 10, 2022 were distributed. Beginning balance was \$4,196.37 with an ending balance of \$4,672.95. Income included return of the Marc deposit of \$150.00, 50/50 tickets sales of \$64.00, sake if leftover food of \$16.00, silent auction of \$230.00, interst of .39, .39, .40, .40, dues from Twirling Funtimers, Twirl-A-Rounds, & Kountry Kuzins. Disbursement for ad for State Federation Festival Booklet of \$30.00. Catherine McLemore stands the Treasurer's report.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

<u>Federation Meeting Report</u> given by Catherine McLemore. Reporting meeting was held July 17, 2022 in St Charles, MO & by Zoom program. Treasurer Report from Rosa Davis shows Total Funds on hand of \$34,906.65 including CD's & interest. Reporting there are 45 clubs this year. Northwest District has a new club in Stewartsville MO called Stewartsville Cut-ups.

Longevity awards are being awarded to Shooting Stars in the Northwest District for 45 years in October & St. Peters Squares in the St. Louis Metro for 60 years in September.

Correspondence letter was received by Liz Rooks from the 42<sup>nd</sup> National Festival Square Dance Convention Committee which hosted the convention in St. Louis in 1993. Enclosed with a check for \$5,000.00 to the Missouri Federation to use in support of educational and promotional activities for square dancing in the state of Missouri.
